## Register today

Every three days, someone dies waiting for a transplant. By registering to become an organ and tissue donor, your death has the power to save or change someone's life.

## Did you know?

- One donor can help over 80 people get back to life.
- Your donation decision is confidential and will not affect your medical care. It will only be disclosed at the end of life. The possibility of donation is only considered when all life-saving efforts have failed.
- Everyone has the potential to be a donor, regardless of age or medical condition.
- Many religions support donation or respect an individual's choice. If you are unsure of your faith's position on donation, consult with your faith leader.
- Donation does not impact funeral plans.
- You can change or withdraw your consent to donation at any time.
