

TGLN's 2020 Yearly Status Report

The points below summarize key accomplishments in this year.

- Continued AODA training of new employees on accessibility standards;
- Review daily the Accessibilities In-box to ensure that queries or requests are answered and actioned in a timely manner;
- TGLN has been using the services of a third-party contractor, Innovasium Digital, to update and test our website (GiftofLife.on.ca) and SidLee to update and test our website (BeADonor.ca) so they meet the WCAG 2.0 Level AA requirements;
- TGLN will review Level AA guidelines annually to ensure that TGLN content continues to conform to WCAG 2.0, Level AA for all new content.
- TGLN has been participating in an AODA working group in 2020 coordinated by Ontario Health. Ontario Health is currently in the process of selecting a vendor who will provide technology services for the AODA remediation work for Ontario Health department websites, including TGLN websites;
- TGLN has identified approximately 396 PDFs that require scanning with the appropriate electronic tool, to be AODA compliant;
- TGLN underwent an AODA desk audit in March 2020, conducted by the Ministry for Seniors and Accessibility. Minor gaps were identified by the Ministry, and TGLN made those applicable changes and received correspondence in September 2020 concluding the completion of our file audit with no further action required.
