Every three days, a person dies waiting for an organ transplant. By registering to become an organ and tissue donor, your death has the power to save or change someone's life.

Facts About Organ and Tissue Donation

- 1 organ and tissue donor can save up to 8 lives and enrich as many as 75.
- The first and foremost duty of health care professionals is to save a life. Only when a life cannot be saved does organ and tissue donation become an option.
- Everyone has the potential to be an organ and/or tissue donor, regardless of age or health.
- The majority of religions support organ and tissue donation or respect an individual's choice.
- Organ and tissue donation should not affect funeral arrangements.
- Your donation decision is confidential and will not affect your medical care. Your donation decision will only be disclosed at the end of life.
- You can change or withdraw your consent to donation at any time.

Registering is easy

Register, then talk to your family

By registering your consent to donation now, you save your family the burden of making the decision for you.
